Item Title: Surplus Property Disposal Ordinance

VILLAGE BOARD ACTION

Pass an ordinance to declare surplus certain personal property of the Village of Roselle, Illinois.

Executive Summary:

Public Works: The following is a brief summary of the vehicles and equipment that staff is seeking to declare as surplus property:

- 1) **Unit 913 - 1991 Chevy Step Van**
VIN # 1GCKP32J2M3306276. Vehicle was used by the Water Division for main breaks and repairs. It has 37,044 miles and was replaced in 2019 due to wear, corrosion and escalating maintenance costs.

- 2) **Unit 554 - 2007 Ford Free Star Van**
VIN # 2FMZA51257BA23232. Vehicle was used by the Fire Department. It has 56,067 miles and was replaced in 2019 due to wear, corrosion and escalating maintenance costs.

- 3) **Unit 041 - 2004 International Dump Truck with Plow and Salt Spreader**
VIN# 1HTWDAAR04J017515. Vehicle was used by the Street Division as the primary snow route truck and general use vehicle. It has 32,767 Miles, 2912 Hours miles and was replaced in 2019 due to wear, corrosion and escalating maintenance costs.

- 4) **Unit 104 - 2011 Ford F-350 Dump with Plow and Spreader.**
VIN # 1FDRF3HT5BEA37357. Vehicle was used by the Street Division as the primary snow route truck and general use vehicle. It has 40,509 miles, 4478 hours miles and was replaced in 2019 due to wear, corrosion and escalating maintenance costs.

5) Unit 051 - 2005 Taurus Sedan

VIN # 1FAFP53UX5A180497. Vehicle used by the Community Development Department. It has 67,000 miles and was replaced in 2019 due to wear, corrosion and escalating maintenance costs. It was replaced with Unit 081 that was rotated in the fleet.

6) Unit 932T 1993 Cronkite Trailer

ID# 473B11417P1110285. Trailer is used by Public Works and is being replaced in 2019 due to wear and corrosion with a new shoring trailer.

Implications:

Is this item budgeted? No. All surplus items have been replaced utilizing budgeted funds or have been determined no longer needed.

Any other implications to be considered? Any revenue generated from the sale/disposal will go to the applicable fund.

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-

AN ORDINANCE TO DECLARE SURPLUS CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE VILLAGE OF ROSELLE, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Roselle that certain personal property of the Village is no longer needed and/or operational and is surplus; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Village to sell or dispose of this personal property; and

WHEREAS, the Village has exhausted the useful life of certain vehicles rendering it obsolete for any future use for the Village;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Roselle, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to sell or dispose of/recycle the following personal property now owned by the Village of Roselle.
