Item Title: **Amendment to Roselle Liquor Ordinance – Increase Class J**

VILLAGE BOARD ACTION

Pass an ordinance amending the “Code of Ordinances, Village of Roselle, Illinois” limitation on the number of licenses covering the sale of alcoholic liquors in the Village of Roselle to increase the number of Class “J” licenses from 2 to 3.

Executive Summary:

Every new liquor license must be accounted for in the Liquor Code. Currently, for the Class J, we have 2 licenses. A new license for El Burrito Fantastico has been created which will increase this to 3 licenses. El Burrito is “testing the market” with a beer and wine license. If they are happy with the response, they plan to request a change to their license to be allowed to serve all alcohol.

This license has been approved by the Liquor Commissioner and the Village Board.

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE
“CODE OF ORDINANCES, VILLAGE OF ROSELLE, ILLINOIS” LIMITATION ON THE
NUMBER OF LICENSES COVERING THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS IN THE
VILLAGE OF ROSELLE TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF CLASS “J” LICENSES
FROM 2 TO 3.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Roselle, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the “Code of Ordinances, Village of Roselle, Illinois,” Chapter 3 entitled, “Alcoholic Beverages, Section 3-33, Limitation on number of Licenses” shall be amended as follows:

Increase the number of Class “J” Licenses from 2 to 3
El Burrito Fantastico – 1228 W. Lake Street

SECTION 2: That all parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3: Should any court of competent jurisdiction find any portion of this Ordinance to be legally invalid; such partial invalidity shall not affect the remainder of the Ordinance.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication in pamphlet form.
