Item Title: **Amendment to Village Vehicle License Code**

VILLAGE BOARD ACTION

Pass an ordinance amending the Village of Roselle Code of Ordinances for the purposes of establishing charges for vehicle licenses.

Executive Summary:

Public Act 100-0956 established a new flat weight tax class (Class C) for trucks weighing between 8,001 lbs. to 10,000 lbs. This act also amended Class D trucks to those weighing between 10,001 lbs. to 12,000 lbs. This act was effective 1/1/2019 and the Village only recently received an inquiry about this new license plate class. Staff proposes a vehicle sticker fee of \$59.00 which is halfway between the Class B and Class D fee.

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF
ROSELLE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE
PURPOSES OF ESTABLISHING CHARGES FOR
VEHICLE LICENSES**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Roselle, under authority of the Illinois Revised Statutes, set fees for annual vehicle stickers from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois passed Public Act 100-0956 effective 1/1/2019 that established truck flat weight tax class C; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to establish a charge for a Class C license;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Roselle, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois that:

SECTION 1: Subsection "B" of Section 103 of Article 20 of Chapter 10 of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Roselle is hereby amended to add the following fee:

B. *Fees.* The annual fees for Village stickers shall be as follows:

<u>Class</u>	<u>License Fee</u>
Class C	59.00

SECTION 2: THAT, all parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 3: THAT, if any item or any portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or the validity thereof of any portion of "Code of Ordinances of the Village of Roselle."
