## **Roselle Police Department Reports Successful *Click It or Ticket; Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over* Mobilizations**

**Who:** Illinois Department of Transportation and **the Roselle Police Department**

**What:** From November 18 through December 1, 2013, Illinois Department of Transportation supported traffic enforcement to remind motorists to buckle up and not drive impaired, both day and night, during the merged Click It or Ticket; Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over mobilizations. Members of the Roselle Police Department joined other state and local law enforcement agencies across Illinois to reduce highway fatalities by cracking down on unbuckled motorists and impaired drivers.

During the mobilization, **Roselle Police** issued the following:

- **73** seat belt citations
- **3** DUI arrests
- **5** suspended/revoked licenses
- **28** uninsured motorists
- **104** speeding citations
- **1** drug arrest

The annual Click It or Ticket mobilization may be over in **Roselle**, but that is no excuse to stop using your seat belt.
