Roselle Police Investigates Fatal Crash

On Tuesday, April 22, 2014 at 6:09 AM, the Roselle Police Department responded to a traffic crash near the intersection of Roselle Road and Rosemont Ave. Responding officers were notified that the crash involved a bicycle. Upon officers arrival it was determined that a 2004 Mercedes Benz van driven by Edward Kowalski, 63 from the 100 block of Rosemont Roselle Illinois, was traveling east on Rosemont Ave. The bicyclist was struck as the van was pulling out of Rosemont Ave turning left onto northbound Roselle Road. The bicyclist, Efrain Diaz-Torres, 47 from the 1800 block of Roselle Road Roselle Illinois, was transported to Alexian Brothers Medical Center where he later died from his injuries. Roselle police officers with the assistance of the DuPage County Accident Reconstruction Team continue to investigate the crash.
