The Roselle Police Arrest Three in \$25,000 Crime Spree

On June 22, 2014, Roselle Police responded to several reports of criminal damage to property that occurred in the western part of the village. Officers learned that damage occurred to several residences and one business using spray paint and eggs. Damaged were 24 cars, 1 boat, 1 motorcycle, 2 garage doors, 1 building, 1 home, 1 port-a-potty, and a sidewalk. Officers learned that the damaged occurred between 4:00 am to 5:30 am on June 22, 2014.

During a month long investigation, Roselle detectives were able to obtain arrest warrants on three offenders. Charged with Class 3 Felony Criminal Damage to Property were:

- Christopher Geldmeyer, (20) residing at 1385 Carriage Way, Roselle, Illinois
- David Henry, (19) residing at 1369 Greenbrook Court, Hanover Park, Illinois
- Damar Elerby, (19) residing at 12 W. Pinehurst, Glendale Heights, Illinois

Geldmeyer was released after posting \$50,000/10% bond pending a DuPage County court date of August 8, 2014. Henry and Elerby were unable to post \$50,000/10% and both were transported to the DuPage County Jail awaiting a bond hearing.
