MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT WITH EXTRICATION

On Sunday April 27th, 2008 at 03:05 a.m., the Roselle Fire Department responded to a reported vehicle accident with injuries on the Elgin-O'Hare Expressway at Roselle Road. Fire and Medic companies responded and found a single vehicle off the road in the median with the driver pinned inside. Medical treatment was rendered as companies worked to extricate the female patient. A Lifestar helicopter was requested to the scene and arrived on scene at 4:02 a.m. Due to the position of the vehicle and amount of damage, an extended amount of time was needed to successfully remove the patient. The Patient was removed at 4:24 a.m. After stabilizing the patient on the scene, she was transported by helicopter to Loyola University Hospital in Maywood, Illinois.

The cause of the accident is under investigation by the State Police. Assistance was received from the Elk Grove Village Fire Department.
