CONDOMINIUM STRUCTURE FIRE

On Tuesday, February 19th, 2008 at 6:38 p.m., the Roselle Fire Department Dispatch received a 911 call reporting a structure fire at 77 W. Central Avenue, Roselle. Fire companies responded and found occupants evacuated from the building and some assisted out by fire and police. Fire suppression measures were taken and the emergency was upgraded to a box alarm level at 6:46 p.m. The fire was extinguished and the box was struck at 7:33 p.m.

Two residents were treated on the scene and transported to Alexian Brothers Medical Center in Elk Grove Village.

The cause of the fire is under investigation. Assistance was received from Bloomingdale, Itasca, Carol Stream, Glenside and Bartlett Fire Protection Districts, Addison, Schaumburg, Hanover Park and Hoffman Estates Fire Departments. Assistance was also provided by the Red Cross.

Roselle Fire and Police Department Investigators are currently interviewing the residence and investigating the scene to determine the cause.
