**EXECUTIVE ORDER OF THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF ROSELLE,
ILLINOIS: "AUTHORIZE THE EXTENSION OF DEADLINES FOR PAYMENTS
OF CERTAIN ADMINISTRATIVE FEES AND REBATES"**

WHEREAS, Article XIX "Emergency and Disasters" of Chapter 2 "Administration" of the Roselle Village Code grants authorization to the Mayor of the Village of Roselle to enter executive orders "upon the declaration of a local state of emergency"; and

WHEREAS, the authority to declare a state of emergency and to issue local executive orders under Chapter 2 Article XIX is exclusive to the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2020, I the Mayor of the Village of Roselle, Andrew Maglio, entered a declaration of local state of emergency based on the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2020, the Governor of the State of Illinois issued Executive Order 2020-10 requiring that all non-essential business and operations cease and requiring all individuals currently living in the State of Illinois to stay at home or their place of residence except as necessary to perform essential activities; and

WHEREAS, I have concluded that an executive order authorizing the extension of deadlines for payments of certain administrative fees and rebates is consistent with my authority under the law and the declaration of emergency because it reduces hardships placed on business owners and residents as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic and the Governor of the State of Illinois' Executive Order 2020-10; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BASED ON THE FOREGOING RECITALS, I, Andrew Maglio, as Mayor of the Village of Roselle, pursuant to my executive powers granted by law and the declaration of emergency, hereby order instantaneously the following without further notice and without action by the Village Board until the next scheduled Village Board meeting.


SECTION 1: Business Licenses. Pursuant to Chapter 9, Article 1, Section 9-9 of the Roselle Municipal Code, all business licenses expire on April 30, 2020. Commencing immediately, all business licenses are hereby extended until May 30, 2020 and no late fees shall be assessed between April 30, 2020 and

May 30, 2020. Commencing no later than May 31, 2020, late fees will be accruing again. Licensees shall submit applications for renewal of their business licenses for the period May 1, 2020 and April 30, 2021 no later than May 30, 2020. All other terms and conditions for the licenses and responsibility of the license holders pursuant to the Roselle Municipal Code remain in full force and effect during the extension period.

SECTION 2: Vehicle Stickers. Pursuant to Chapter 10, Article XX, Section 10-20-103 of the Roselle Traffic Code, the license year for Village vehicle stickers runs from June 1 to May 31 of the following year. The current license year for Village vehicle stickers that expire on May 31, 2020 is hereby extended until July 31, 2020 and no late fees shall be extended between May 31, 2020 and July 31, 2020. Commencing on August 1, 2020, late fees will begin accruing again. Every owner of a motor vehicle or motorbike as defined in Section 10-20-101 who is obligated under the Code of Ordinances of the Village to have a Village vehicle sticker shall submit applications and payment for renewal of their vehicle stickers for the period June 1, 2020 and May 31, 2021 no later than July 31, 2020. All other terms and conditions for vehicle stickers and responsibility of the owners of motor vehicles or motorbikes pursuant to the Roselle Traffic Code remain in full force and effect during this extension period.

SECTION 3: Senior Utility Tax Rebate. The last date the Village will accept applications to qualify for a senior utility tax rebate is hereby extended from April 30, 2020 to May 30, 2020.
