**Item Title:** DuPage County Stormwater & Floodplain Ordinance Adoption

**COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE ACTION**

**Direction authorizing the Public Works Director to present an ordinance to the Village Board for the adoption of an Ordinance that adopts the most current DuPage County Stormwater and Floodplain Ordinance, dated May 14<sup>th</sup>, 2019.**

**Executive Summary:**

On May 14<sup>th</sup>, 2019, DuPage County passed an amendment to the Countywide Stormwater & Floodplain Ordinance. The revision includes a reference to the new Flood Insurance Rate Maps dated August 1, 2019 and the associated studies.

The proposed Village ordinance will supplement the current existing floodplain and stormwater detention ordinances found in the Village code of ordinances. This section of the existing Village Code is based on a compilation of ordinances passed in 1986, 1987 and 1996.

The new ordinance will create a separate Appendix D – Stormwater and Floodplain Regulations that simply references the 150-page DuPage County Stormwater & Floodplain Ordinance, dated May 14<sup>th</sup>, 2019 by reference. This ordinance is the most up-to-date floodplain and stormwater management standards that the Village is currently enforcing.

Community Development will be subsequently revising the zoning portion of the Village Code to incorporate these requirements. In a related issue, the Village must also separately adopt the new floodplain maps in order remain compliant with the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP).

**ORDINANCE NO. 2019-**

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THE DUPAGE COUNTY  
COUNTYWIDE STORMWATER AND FLOOD PLAIN MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE**

**WHEREAS**, the County of DuPage, pursuant to the powers granted to it by 55 ILCS 5/5-1062, adopted the DuPage County Countywide Stormwater and Flood Plain Management Ordinance on or about October 1991, effective February 1992, establishing rules and regulations for floodplain and stormwater management throughout the County of DuPage and superseding any less restrictive municipal rules and regulations therein; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Roselle have previously adopted Ordinances No. 2013-3694 on August 26, 2013, which adopted by reference the DuPage Stormwater Management and Flood Plain Ordinance; and,

**WHEREAS**, the County of DuPage, pursuant to the powers granted to it by 55 ILCS 5/5-1062, adopted a resolution approving amendments to the DuPage County Stormwater and Flood Plain Management Ordinance on or about May 14th, 2019; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Roselle find it to be in the best interests of the Village of Roselle to require all development to, at least meet, the minimum standards prescribed by the DuPage County Stormwater and Flood Plain Management Ordinance to the fullest extent practicable; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by Board of Trustees of the Village of Roselle, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That there is hereby adopted by reference, as if fully set out herein, that certain ordinance known as the DuPage County Stormwater and Flood Plain Management Ordinance, approved as amended by the County of DuPage, State of Illinois, one copy of which has been and will continue to be on file in the office of the Director of Community Development.

**SECTION 2:** That in the event that the rules, regulations, terms or conditions imposed pursuant to the DuPage County Stormwater and Flood Plain Management Ordinance are either more restrictive or less restrictive than comparable rules, regulations, terms or conditions imposed by any other applicable rule, regulation, resolution, ordinance, statute or law, then the most restrictive rules, regulations, terms or conditions shall govern.

**SECTION 3:** That Appendix D-Stormwater and Flood Plain Management Regulations of the Village Code of the Village of Roselle is added to the Village Code with the following:

**APPENDIX D – STORMWATER AND FLOOD PLAIN MANAGEMENT REGULATIONS:**

**Sec. D-1 – DuPage County Stormwater and Flood Plain Management Ordinance.**

The DuPage County Stormwater and Flood Plain Management Ordinance, as amended by the County of DuPage on May 14<sup>th</sup>, 2019, is hereby adopted by reference and is in full force and effect within the Village of Roselle and is found in its own compilation. This ordinance and standards contained herein shall apply as the minimum standards to all properties within the Village's corporate limits and within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the Village or that may be annexed into the Village, including those properties located in Cook County and DuPage County.

**SECTION 4:** That all ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such inconsistency, are hereby expressly repealed and rescinded.

**SECTION 5:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
