**Item Title:** Amend the No Parking Zone on Rodenburg Road for Waterbury School

**COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE ACTION**

**Consider a staff recommendation to repeal the existing no parking zone at Waterbury School and approve an ordinance establishing specific parking restrictions on Rodenburg Road near Waterbury School as outlined in attached ordinance.**

**Executive Summary:**

In 2019 Kneeneyville School District 20 completed parking and bus drop-off improvements to Waterbury School located at 355 S. Rodenburg Road, Roselle. With these changes the police department worked with the Waterbury School staff to review parking on Rodenburg to determine if the current parking restrictions best serve student safety and meet the parking needs of the neighborhood. With these parking improvements we feel the parking restrictions in the area need modifications. These modifications will deal with student drop-off and pick-up, we have seen parents park their cars, leave them unattended to walk their children into the school, or leave the cars unattended to pick up their children. The School Staff has requested and the Police Department agrees there is a need to restrict parking in front of the school on school days between the hours of student drop-off and pick-up. This proposed ordinance restricts parking of vehicles on school days between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. and also 2:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. This proposed ordinance does not restrict parents from waiting in their cars, it prohibits parking unoccupied vehicles during these times.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10,  
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES**

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Roselle deem that regulating parking of vehicles on Village Streets increases the safety and welfare of the citizens of Roselle, and unregulated parking in defined areas is detrimental to the welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Roselle.

**SECTION 1:** NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Roselle, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois, that Chapter 10, Appendix V, Section 5A: No Parking on school days at designated times; of the Code of Ordinances is hereby repealed and rescinded in its entirety:

**Rodenburg Road -** There shall be "no parking" between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. on the east side which runs concurrently with the property of School District 20, except there shall be "no parking on school days from 8:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. and from 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. from a point 429 feet north of the north curb line of Waterbury Lane to a point 557 feet north of the curb line of Waterbury Lane except stopping or standing shall be allowed for drop-off and pick-up and "no parking" signs shall so state

**SECTION 2:** That Chapter 10, Appendix V, Section 5A: No Parking on school days at designated times; of the Code of Ordinances shall be replaced with:

**Rodenburg Road –** There shall be “no parking on school days” between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. and between the hours of 2:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. on both the east and west sides of Rodenburg Road adjacent to the property of School District 20. This area designated as ‘no parking on school days’ will be on Rodenburg Road 225 feet north of the curb line of Waterbury Lane to 115 feet south of the curb line of Darby Lane, except stopping or standing shall be allowed for drop-off and pick-up and no parking signs shall so state.

**SECTION 3:** THAT if any part, portion or section of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of any other portion of the “Code of Ordinances of the Village of Roselle”.

**SECTION 4:** THAT all parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION 5:** THAT this amending ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as is hereby authorized to be done by the Mayor and Board of Trustees.
