Item Title: **New Liquor License Classification – Class U**

VILLAGE BOARD ACTION

Pass an ordinance amending Section 3-32 “Classification of Licenses” and Section 3-34 “Terms and Fees” of Chapter Three “Roselle Liquor Control Ordinance” of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Roselle.

Executive Summary:

At its meeting on June 14, 2021, the Village Board recommended approval of a new license classification. The creation of a new license classification will allow license holders to sell beer, wine, and spirits for onsite consumption and beer and spirits for offsite consumption with limitations. Beer may only be sold for off premise consumption in unopened original manufacturers containers or growlers or crowlers, which comply in all respects with applicable provisions of 235 ILCS 6-6.5. Spirits may be sold for off premise consumption but only if distilled by the Licensee and sealed in a container fully conforming with state law. The annual fee for a Class U license is \$1,750.

ORDINANCE NO. 2021

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3-32 “CLASSIFICATION OF LICENSES” AND SECTION 3-34 “TERMS AND FEES” OF CHAPTER THREE “ROSELLE LIQUOR CONTROL ORDINANCE” OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF ROSELLE

WHEREAS, the Village of Roselle controls the sale of alcohol beverages through Chapter Three, “Roselle Liquor Control Ordinance”, of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Roselle; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Liquor Control Act and the Village of Roselle Liquor Control Ordinance authorizes the Village of Roselle to license and regulate establishments that sell and dispense alcoholic beverages; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Board of Trustees for the Village of Roselle, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois that Chapter Three “Roselle Liquor Control Ordinance” of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Roselle is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1: That Section 3-32 “Classification of Licenses” is hereby amended to include a new sub-classification: “U” license, Subsection 21; which shall read:

Section 3-32. (21) Class “U” license shall authorize the retail sale for on premise consumption of beer, wine and spirits. Beer may also be sold for off premise consumption in unopened original manufacturers containers or growlers or crowlers, which comply in all respects with applicable provisions of 235 ILCS 6-6.5. Spirits may be sold for off premise consumption but only if distilled by the Licensee and sealed in a container fully conforming with state law.

SECTION 2: That the schedule set forth in Section 3-34 “Terms and Fees” of Chapter Three, “Roselle Liquor Control Ordinance”, is hereby amended by the addition of a Class “U” license the fees for which shall be as follows:

An annual license fee of One Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty Dollar (\$1,750).

SECTION 3: That if any part or portion of this Ordinance is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such partial invalidity shall not affect the remainder of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as is hereby authorized and directed to be done by the Mayor and Board of Trustees.
