Item Title: Amendment to Roselle Liquor Ordinance – Increase Class T

VILLAGE BOARD ACTION

Pass an ordinance amending the “Code of Ordinances, Village of Roselle, Illinois” limitation on number of licenses covering the sale of alcoholic liquors in the Village of Roselle to increase in the number of Class “T” Licenses from 14 to 15 for Crazy Crab Restaurant.

Executive Summary:

This ordinance will update the Liquor Code to reflect the number of Class T licenses issued. Crazy Crab has not completed their video surveillance requirements, so the actual license will not be released until the Police Department gives their final approval. Approving the license now allows for the Clerk’s office to prepare the license as soon as Police Department approval is given, without waiting until the next Village Board meeting.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE
“CODE OF ORDINANCES, VILLAGE OF ROSELLE, ILLINOIS” LIMITATION ON
NUMBER OF LICENSES COVERING THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS IN THE
VILLAGE OF ROSELLE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Roselle, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the “Code of Ordinances, Village of Roselle, Illinois,” Chapter 3 entitled, “Alcoholic Beverages, Section 3-33, Limitation on number of Licenses” shall be amended as follows:

Increase the number of Class “T” Licenses from 14 to 15
Crazy Crab Corporation – 996 W. Lake St. Roselle

SECTION 2: That all parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3: Should any court of competent jurisdiction find any portion of this ordinance to be legally invalid; such partial invalidity shall not affect the remainder of the ordinance.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication in pamphlet form.
