Item Title: Illinois Department of Transportation Maintenance Permit Resolution

VILLAGE BOARD ACTION

Adopt an Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) Resolution allowing the Village of Roselle to perform work in right-of-ways under the jurisdiction of the State of Illinois.

Executive Summary:

Every two years, the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) requires municipalities to adopt a resolution which permits the municipality to work on certain utilities and municipal owned infrastructure located within right-of-ways under the jurisdiction of the State of Illinois. The attached resolution allows the Village to perform work associated with the location, construction, operation and maintenance of driveways, street returns, water mains, sanitary and storm sewers, streetlights, traffic signals, sidewalks, landscaping, etc. without having to obtain a permit for each occurrence thus saving the Village time and allowing an immediate response when necessary.

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-

**AN I.D.O.T. RESOLUTION
ALLOWING THE VILLAGE OF ROSELLE TO PERFORM WORK IN
RIGHT-OF-WAYS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS**

Whereas, the VILLAGE OF ROSELLE hereinafter referred to as MUNICIPALITY, located in the County of DUPAGE AND COOK, State of Illinois, desires to undertake, in the years 2022 and 2023, the location, construction, operation and maintenance of driveways and street returns, water mains, sanitary and storm sewers, street lights, traffic signals, sidewalks, landscaping, etc., on State highways, within said MUNICIPALITY, which by law and/or agreement come under the jurisdiction and control of the Department of Transportation of the State of Illinois hereinafter referred to as Department, and,

Whereas, an individual working permit must be obtained from the Department prior to any of the aforesaid installations being constructed either by the MUNICIPALITY or by a private person or firm under contract and supervision of the MUNICIPALITY.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the MUNICIPALITY:

FIRST: That MUNICIPALITY hereby pledges its good faith and guarantees that all work shall be performed in accordance with conditions of the permit to be granted by the Department, and to hold State of Illinois harmless during the prosecution of such work and assume all liability for damages to person or property due to accidents or otherwise by reason of the work which it to be performed under the provision of said permit.

SECOND: That all authorized officials of the MUNICIPALITY are hereby instructed and authorized to sign said working permit on behalf of the MUNICIPALITY.
