Item Title: **Amendment to the Liquor Ordinance – Class “U” License**

VILLAGE BOARD ACTION

Amend the Roselle Liquor Code by decreasing the number of Class “U” licenses from 2 to 1. (Relative Brewery)

Executive Summary:

Relative Brewing Company, Inc., initiated a liquor license application in June, 2021. Their license was approved by the Board at the same time that the classifications were changed for Pollyanna (and Relative Brewery). Since there has been no further movement on the part of Relative Brewery to open a business or for obtaining the liquor license, we are recommending decreasing the number of licenses for this classification. Relative Brewery would be eligible in the future to request a Class U license.

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE
“CODE OF ORDINANCES, VILLAGE OF ROSELLE, ILLINOIS” LIMITATION ON
NUMBER OF LICENSES COVERING THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS IN THE
VILLAGE OF ROSELLE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Roselle, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the “Code of Ordinances, Village of Roselle, Illinois,” Chapter 3 entitled, “Alcoholic Beverages, Section 3-33, Limitation on number of Licenses” shall be amended as follows:

Decrease the number of Class “U” Licenses from 2 to 1
(Relative Brewery and Tap Room, 10 Spring St., Roselle, never finalized its license)

SECTION 2: That all parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3: Should any court of competent jurisdiction find any portion of this ordinance to be legally invalid; such partial invalidity shall not affect the remainder of the ordinance.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication in pamphlet form.
