Item Title: Ordinance to Amend the Roselle Liquor Code - Class "J" Licenses

VILLAGE BOARD ACTION

Pass an ordinance amending the "Code of Ordinances, Village of Roselle, Illinois" limitation on number of licenses covering the sale of alcoholic liquors in the Village of Roselle by decreasing the number of Class "J" licenses from 5 to 4 (Hannah's Bistro).

Executive Summary:

Hannah's Bistro failed to renew their 2021 liquor license due to extended repairs and construction of their building. A three-month grace period was granted and has expired. The building is currently under the plan review process for the interior repairs and renovations. It is recommended that the number of licenses for this classification be decreased. Hannah's Bistro would be eligible in the future to request a Class "J" license.

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE
“CODE OF ORDINANCES, VILLAGE OF ROSELLE, ILLINOIS” LIMITATION ON
NUMBER OF LICENSES COVERING THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS IN THE
VILLAGE OF ROSELLE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Roselle, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the “Code of Ordinances, Village of Roselle, Illinois,” Chapter 3 entitled, “Alcoholic Beverages, Section 3-33, Limitation on number of Licenses” shall be amended as follows:

Decrease the number of Class “J” Licenses from 5 to 4
(Hannah’s Bistro, 11 Monaco Drive, Roselle, failure to renew its license)

SECTION 2: That all parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3: Should any court of competent jurisdiction find any portion of this ordinance to be legally invalid; such partial invalidity shall not affect the remainder of the ordinance.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication in pamphlet form.
