Item Title: **Class T Liquor License and Fees Update**

VILLAGE BOARD ACTION

Pass an ordinance amending Section 3-32 “Classification of Licenses” and Section 3-34 “Terms and Fees” of Chapter Three “Roselle Liquor Control Ordinance” of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Roselle.

Executive Summary:

In December 2021 the Illinois Video Gaming Act was amended in part to allow non-home rule municipalities to impose an annual fee for the operation of each video gaming terminal not to exceed \$250 per year. State statute previously capped this non-home rule video gaming terminal fee at \$25 per terminal per year. In addition, the Act was further amended to require the annual fee to be shared equally between the terminal operator and the applicable licensed establishment. The Board approved the terminal fee increase during the FY22 budget process. Attached is an ordinance amending the Liquor Code to include the updated fee and a new section stating the fee shall be shared between the license holder and terminal operator.

Staff will prepare a letter to be sent to all Class T license holders upon adoption of the ordinance indicating the fee increase and shared cost language. Invoices to the license holders will be sent the first full week of March 2022 and also include a note regarding the increase and shared cost language.

Implications:

Is this item budgeted? The FY22 budget includes the projected revenue for the updated fee of \$250 for each video gaming terminal.

ORDINANCE NO. 2022

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3-32 “CLASSIFICATION OF LICENSES” AND SECTION 3-34 “TERMS AND FEES” OF CHAPTER THREE “ROSELLE LIQUOR CONTROL ORDINANCE” OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF ROSELLE

WHEREAS, the Village of Roselle controls the sale of alcohol beverages through Chapter Three, “Roselle Liquor Control Ordinance”, of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Roselle; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Liquor Control Act and the Village of Roselle Liquor Control Ordinance authorizes the Village of Roselle to license and regulate establishments that sell and dispense alcoholic beverages; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Board of Trustees for the Village of Roselle, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois that Chapter Three “Roselle Liquor Control Ordinance” of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Roselle is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1: That sub-section 20 of Section 3-32 “Classification of Licenses” is hereby amended by the addition of a new subsection (i) under which shall read:

Section 3-32. (20)(i) Class “T” license holders shall share the annual fee per video gaming device with the terminal operator.

SECTION 2: That the schedule set forth in Section 3-34 “Terms and Fees” of Chapter Three, “Roselle Liquor Control Ordinance”, is hereby amended by repealing and rescinding the current Class “T” annual fees and adopting new fees for the Class T license as follows:

An annual license fee of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) plus Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250) per year per video gaming device.

SECTION 3: That if any part or portion of this Ordinance is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such partial invalidity shall not affect the remainder of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as is hereby authorized and directed to be done by the Mayor and Board of Trustees.
