**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-**

**A RESOLUTION TO CLOSE A STATE HIGHWAY  
FOR THE PURPOSE OF HOLDING AN ANNUAL PARADE**

WHEREAS, the Chamber of Commerce and Industry of the Village of Roselle desires to hold their Rose Parade starting at Turner Park, proceeding south from Turner Park onto Roselle Road to Thorndale, east to Prospect, south to Irving Park Road, east on Irving Park Road to Lawrence Avenue, on Sunday, June 5, 2022; and

WHEREAS, said parade will require the closing of Route 19 either partially or completely between Maple Avenue and Roselle Road; and

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois requires the Village to assume all responsibility and liability involved in the closing of said highway,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Roselle that said Village will assume full responsibility for the direction, protection and regulation of traffic during the time the detour is in effect and all liabilities for damages of any kind occasioned by the closing of said State Route.

It is further agreed that efficient, all-weather detours will be maintained, conspicuously marked and judiciously police patrolled for the benefit of traffic deviated from the State Route.

Nothing contained herein shall be interpreted to waive or suspend any and all privileges or immunities extended to the Village by reason of statutory or common law.
