Item Title: Surplus Property Disposal Ordinance

VILLAGE BOARD ACTION

Pass an ordinance to declare surplus, certain personal property of the Village of Roselle.

Executive Summary:

Staff has completed a review of operations and equipment needs and have determined there are three vehicles that can be disposed due to age and condition. These vehicles have already been replaced with new vehicles.

Staff will attempt to auction the vehicles on the internet via Govdeals, which has been used successfully in the past. Anything not purchased will be recycled, if possible.

Implications:

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-

**AN ORDINANCE TO DECLARE SURPLUS CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY OF
THE VILLAGE OF ROSELLE, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Roselle that certain personal property of the Village is no longer needed and/or operational and is surplus; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Village to sell or dispose of this personal property; and

WHEREAS, the Village has exhausted the useful life of certain vehicles, rendering it obsolete for any future use for the Village;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Roselle, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to dispose of/recycle the following personal property now owned by the Village of Roselle as included in Exhibit A.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, by a vote of at least three-fourths of the corporate authorities and approval in the manner provided by law.
