Executive Summary:

1. On 09/13/2022, the Village Board approved the Class “F” liquor license for Mangy Dawg Pub Roselle at 101 E. Irving Park Road. In anticipation of their opening, Mangy Dawg Pub Roselle has fulfilled the requirements for obtaining their liquor license.

2. On 9/13/2022, the Village Board also approved the Class “T” liquor license for Mangy Dawg Pub Roselle at 101 E. Irving Park Road. This Ordinance will update the Liquor Code to reflect the number of Class “T” licenses issued. Mangy Dawg Pub Roselle has not yet completed their video surveillance requirements; therefore, the actual license will not be released until the Roselle Police Department gives their final approval. Approving the license now allows the Village Clerk’s office to prepare the license. Upon RPD approval, the Clerk will prepare the license without the need to wait until the next Village Board meeting.

**AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING THE “CODE OF ORDINANCES,
VILLAGE OF ROSELLE, ILLINOIS”
LIMITATION ON NUMBER OF LICENSES COVERING
THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS IN
THE VILLAGE OF ROSELLE**

WHEREAS, the Village of Roselle (hereinafter referred to as the “Village”) is an Illinois Municipal Corporation organized pursuant to the laws of the State of Illinois;

WHEREAS, the Village has in full force and effect a codified set of ordinances which are of a general and permanent nature, which said codified set is known and designated as the Village Code of the Village of Roselle, as amended;

WHEREAS, the Village has the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs that protect the health, safety and welfare of its residents;

WHEREAS, Section 11-42-10.1 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-42-10.1, and Section 4-1 of the Illinois Liquor Control Act, 235 ILCS 5/4-1, provide the Village the authority to determine the number, kind, and classification of licenses for the sale of alcoholic liquor;

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village desire have determined that it is in the best interests of the Village to amend its liquor code to provide for an additional liquor license within the respective “classification”; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Roselle are of the opinion that it is in the best interests of the safety, health and welfare of the residents to amend the village’s code of ordinances as referenced herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, in open meeting assembled, by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Roselle, Cook and DuPage Counties, Illinois as follows:

Section One - Recitals

The Board of Trustees hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preamble to this ordinance are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this ordinance as legislative findings.

Section Two – Amendment Village Code of Ordinances

That the “Code of Ordinances, Village of Roselle, Illinois,” Chapter 3 entitled, “Alcoholic Beverages, Section 3-33, Limitation on number of Licenses” shall be amended as follows:

Increase the number of Class “F” Licenses from 13 to 14
(Mangy Dawg Pub Roselle, 101 E. Irving Park Road)

Section Three – Codification

The title, chapter(s) and section(s) adopted by this ordinance shall be numbered and placed in an appropriate title, chapter(s), and section(s) when and during the codification of the Roselle Municipal Code.

Section Four - Conflict Clause

That all ordinances, parts of ordinances, resolutions, parts of resolutions or board actions in conflict with the terms of this ordinance shall be repealed to the extent of said conflict.

Section Five - Passage Clause

That this ordinance shall take full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

Section Six - Constitutionality Clause

Any part or parts of this ordinance declared by a court of law to be invalid or unconstitutional shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance or the Roselle Municipal Code.

Section Seven - Publication

This ordinance shall be published in book or pamphlet form as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code.

Section Eight - Recording

This ordinance shall be entered into the minutes and upon the journals of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Roselle.

WHEREAS, the Village of Roselle (hereinafter referred to as the “Village”) is an Illinois Municipal Corporation organized pursuant to the laws of the State of Illinois;

WHEREAS, the Village has in full force and effect a codified set of ordinances which are of a general and permanent nature, which said codified set is known and designated as the Village Code of the Village of Roselle, as amended;

WHEREAS, the Village has the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs that protect the health, safety and welfare of its residents;

WHEREAS, the Village desires to amend its code of ordinances to increase the number of Class “T” licenses from sixteen (16) to seventeen (17) for Mangy Dawg Pub Roselle – 101 E. Irving Park Road, Roselle, Illinois.

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Roselle are of the opinion that it is in the best interests of the safety, health and welfare of the residents to amend the village’s code of ordinances as referenced herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, in open meeting assembled, by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Roselle, Cook and DuPage Counties, Illinois as follows:

Section One - Recitals

The Board of Trustees hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preamble to this ordinance are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this ordinance as legislative findings.

Section Two – Amendment to Village Code of Ordinances Chapter 3, Section 3-33

Chapter 3, Section 3-33, entitled, “Alcoholic Beverages, Section 3-33, Limitation on Number of Licenses”, shall be amended as follows: Increase the number of Class “T” licenses from 16 to 17.

Section Three – Codification

The title, chapter(s) and section(s) adopted by this ordinance shall be numbered and placed in an appropriate title, chapter(s), and section(s) when and during the codification of the Roselle Municipal Code.

Section Four - Conflict Clause

That all ordinances, parts of ordinances, resolutions, parts of resolutions or board actions

in conflict with the terms of this ordinance shall be repealed to the extent of said conflict.

Section Five - Passage Clause

That this ordinance shall take full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

Section Six - Constitutionality Clause

Any part or parts of this ordinance declared by a court of law to be invalid or unconstitutional shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance or the Roselle Municipal Code.

Section Seven - Publication
