**A RESOLUTION
TO CLOSE A STATE HIGHWAY FOR
THE PURPOSE OF HOLDING
THE ANNUAL ROSE PARADE**

WHEREAS, the Village of Roselle is a municipal corporation organized pursuant to the laws of the State of Illinois possessing certain powers and perform certain functions pertaining to its local government and affairs as provided for by and through the Illinois Constitution of 1970, Illinois Municipal Code and Illinois Statute;

WHEREAS, the Village of Roselle (hereinafter referred to as "Village") and the Roselle Chamber of Commerce and Industry desires to hold the annual Rose Parade on Sunday, June 4, 2023,

WHEREAS, the parade will begin at Turner Park and proceed as follows: south from Turner Park onto Roselle Road to Hattendorf, east to Prospect, south to Irving Park Road, east on Irving Park Road to Lawrence Avenue,

WHEREAS, as a result of the parade route, Route 19 will need to be closed either partially or completely between Maple Avenue and Roselle Road;

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois requires the Village to assume all responsibility and liability involved in the closing of said highway, and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Roselle are of the opinion that it is in the best interests of the health, welfare and safety of the residents of the Village to close the state highway for the purpose of conducting the annual Rose Parade as provided for herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, in open meeting assembled, by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Roselle, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois, as follows:

Section One – Recitals

The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preamble to the resolution are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this resolution as legislative findings.

Section Two – Authorization of Closure of Route 19

- a) The Corporate Authorities hereby approve and authorize the closure of Route 19 between Maple Avenue and Roselle Road on June 4, 2023,
- b) The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file this Resolution with the Illinois Department of Transportation along with any other federal, state or local agencies that may need to be notified in order to effectuate the closure of Route 19 as set forth herein,
- c) The Village shall assume full responsibility for the direction protection and regulation of traffic during the time the detour is in effect and all liabilities for damages of any kind occasioned by the closing of said State Route,

- d) The Village agrees that efficient, all-weather detours will be maintained, conspicuously marked and judiciously police patrolled for the benefit of traffic deviated from the State Route,
- e) Village Staff is further authorized to take all necessary and required actions to assist in the closure of Route 19, and
- f) Nothing contained herein shall be interpreted to waive or suspend any and all privileges or immunities extended to the Village by reason of statutory or common law.

Section Three – Effective Date

This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

Section Four - Publication

This resolution shall be published in book or pamphlet form as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code.

Section Five – Saving Clause

If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this resolution is declared by a court of law to be invalid or unconstitutional, the invalidity or unconstitutionality thereof shall not affect the validity of any other provisions of this resolution which are hereby declared to be separable.

Section Six – Conflict Clause

All resolutions, parts of resolutions or board actions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section Seven – Recording

This resolution shall be entered into the minutes and upon the journals of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Roselle.
