Item Title: **Municipal Parking Lots – Holiday Parking**

OLD BUSINESS

VILLAGE BOARD ACTION:

Pass an ordinance amending Chapter 18, Article VI, of the code of ordinances of the Village of Roselle, Illinois.

Executive Summary:

The Village currently allows free parking in commuter parking lots on the following five (5) observed holidays: Independence Day, Memorial Day, Labor Day, Christmas Day, and New Year’s Day. On June 26, 2023 the Village Board approved an ordinance amendment for construction hours to be allowed on the same aforementioned holidays including Thanksgiving Day. In preparation of installing more specific signage at the commuter lots in relation to overnight parking hours and Village recognized holidays, staff now recommends including Thanksgiving Day for free parking in the commuter lots. The changes are reflected in the attached ordinance.

Below is a report of other municipalities’ recognized holidays that permit free parking in municipal lots:

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
CHAPTER 18 ARTICLE VI
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF
THE VILLAGE OF ROSELLE, ILLINOIS
(MUNICIPAL PARKING LOTS)**

WHEREAS, the Village of Roselle (hereinafter referred to as the “Village”) is an Illinois Municipal Corporation organized pursuant to the laws of the State of Illinois;

WHEREAS, the Village has in full force and effect a codified set of ordinances which are of a general and permanent nature, which said codified set is known and designated as the Village Code of the Village of Roselle, as amended;

WHEREAS, the Village has the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs that protect the health, safety and welfare of its residents;

WHEREAS, staff routinely reviews the Village Code to ensure that Village Code is properly updated to reflect not only changes in law and statute but technology;

WHEREAS, amendments to Village Code are necessary to correspond with the enforcement of municipal parking lots;

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Roselle are of the opinion that it is in the best interests of the safety, health and welfare of the residents to amend the village’s code of ordinances as referenced herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, in open meeting assembled, by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Roselle, Cook and DuPage Counties, Illinois as follows:

Section One - Recitals

The Board of Trustees hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preamble to this ordinance are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this ordinance as legislative findings.

Section Two – Amendment Village Code of Ordinances Chapter 18 Article VI

The following sections of Chapter 18 Article VI shall be amended as follows (additions appearing underlined and any deleted language appearing with a ~~strike-through~~ line):

Sec. 18-91.5. Periods of free overnight parking.

Persons may park any vehicle in the free overnight municipal parking lots designated in section 18-91.4, without payment of a daily fee or the possession of a valid parking permit, during the following periods: between 4:00 p.m., local time, of any day and 5:00 a.m. on the following day and at any time on Saturday, Sunday or on Independence Day, Memorial Day, Labor Day,

Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day.

Sec. 18-91.7. Periods of free night and weekend parking

Persons may park any vehicle in the free of the night and weekend municipal parking lots designated in section 18-91.7, without payment of a daily fee or the possession and display of a valid individually coded parking card, during the following periods: between 4:00 p.m., local time, of any day and 2:00 a.m. on the following day; and at any time on Saturday, Sunday, or on Independence Day, Memorial Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day.

Section Three – Codification

The title, chapter(s) and section(s) adopted by this ordinance shall be numbered and placed in an appropriate title, chapter(s), and section(s) when and during the codification of the Roselle Municipal Code.

Section Four - Conflict Clause

That all ordinances, parts of ordinances, resolutions, parts of resolutions or board actions in conflict with the terms of this ordinance shall be repealed to the extent of said conflict.

Section Five - Passage Clause

That this ordinance shall take full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

Section Six - Constitutionality Clause

Any part or parts of this ordinance declared by a court of law to be invalid or unconstitutional shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance or the Roselle Municipal Code.

Section Seven - Publication

This ordinance shall be published in book or pamphlet form as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code.

Section Eight - Recording

This ordinance shall be entered into the minutes and upon the journals of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Roselle.
