## The Roselle Police Department Says Have a Game Plan for Super Bowl Sunday: Are You Drinking or Driving?

**Roselle, Illinois**— The Roselle Police Department announced today it will conduct special patrols this Super Bowl weekend, cracking down on alcohol- and drug-impaired drivers and seat belt law violators.

Impaired driving crashes are completely preventable. All it takes is a game plan. Fans need to remember that it's a choice, and the choice is simple. Drink *or* drive—but never do both. If you do, you will be arrested.

If you plan on drinking alcohol while cheering on your team, pass your keys to a sober driver before the Super Bowl party begins. Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over.

Motorists also can anticipate tickets for ignoring seat belt laws.

Designating a sober driver before the party and not letting friends drive drunk or drug-impaired are two simple steps to help avoid a tragic crash or an arrest due to impaired driving. Other important tips include:

- Call a taxi or ride share service, use mass transit, or call a sober friend or family member to get you home safely;
- Report drunk drivers to law enforcement;
- Spend the night where the activity is being held and sleep it off;
- Always buckle up. And make sure every passenger is wearing a seat belt.
