Village of Roselle Changing Business Operations, Canceling Events in Response to Coronavirus Pandemic

The Village of Roselle is implementing temporary changes to its business operations in order to help protect public health and slow the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19), including canceling non-essential meetings and special events, suspending non-essential inspections, and limiting Village employee exposure to the public while continuing to provide core services to the community.

Effectively immediately through April 30, 2020, all non-essential meetings and special events that require the use of municipal facilities in the Village of Roselle are canceled. A full list of these cancellations is available on the Village's website at www.roselle.il.us. Roselle Public Works at 474 Congress Circle W. is an official polling place and will be open to voters on March 17, 2020, for the General Primary Election.

Residents are urged to utilize the Village's website pay bills and invoices and to apply for certain building permits (www.roselle.il.us/payments) instead of conducting this business in person. Payments and other correspondence can also be done through the drop box in the circle drive in front of Village Hall, 31 S. Prospect St.

"The safety and well-being of Roselle residents remains the priority of elected officials and staff here in the Village," said Mayor Andy Maglio. "We are acting proactively to protect the community and are monitoring reliable sources for best practices concerning the coronavirus while continuing to provide essential services to our residents."

There are no current plans to close public facilities in the Village of Roselle. Extra cleaning and disinfection of doors, walkways, and restrooms is being done in the Village's municipal facilities, including the Roselle Metra Station, and hand sanitizing stations are available at all counters where the public interacts with staff.
