Village of Roselle Closing Municipal Buildings, Modifying Operations Amid Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic

- All municipal buildings in the Village of Roselle are closed to the public starting March 18, 2020, with extremely limited in-person access available at the Roselle Police Station, 103 S. Prospect St.
- The public is urged to conduct business and make requests for service with the Village by phone, by e-mail or online at www.roselle.il.us/E-Services.
- All board and commission meetings are canceled until further notice.

Municipal Buildings Closing

The Village of Roselle is closing its facilities (Village Hall, Fire Station, Police Station, and Public Works Building) to the public starting at the close of the business day on Tuesday, March 17, 2020, to help protect public health and the health, safety and welfare of employees amid the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. These facilities will be closed through at least April 5, 2020, with options to reopen evaluated at that time.

These closures are in addition to the already announced cancellation (www.roselle.il.us/ArchiveCenter/ViewFile/Item/2153) of all non-essential meetings and special events in the Village through April 30, 2020.

Conducting Business With the Village

While the buildings are closed to the public, the Village's employees will continue to work on-site and remotely to ensure that essential services continue to be offered in Roselle. The public is urged to conduct business with the Village online or by phone to the greatest extent possible. Payments for fees and invoices to the Village can be made online at www.roselle.il.us/payments, through online payment programs offered through banks, or in the drop box in the circle drive in front of Village Hall, 31 S. Prospect St.

Concerns, questions and other communications can also be done through the Village's online Form Center at www.roselle.il.us/FormCenter, and links to other online based municipal services are available at www.roselle.il.us/E-Services. For extreme situations that require in-person interaction, staff will be available to assist the public in the lobby of the Roselle Police Station, 103 S. Prospect St.

Board and Commission Meetings Canceled

All scheduled board and commission meetings, including those for the Village Board, Planning and Zoning Commission, Zoning Board of Appeals, Board of Fire and Police Commissioners, pension boards, and TIF review boards are canceled until further notice.
