**EXECUTIVE ORDER OF THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF ROSELLE, ILLINOIS,
AUTHORIZING THE POLICE CHIEF AND VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO HAVE
THE DISCRETION TO MODIFY COMMUTER PARKING**

WHEREAS, Article XIX "Emergency and Disasters" of Chapter 2 "Administration" of the Roselle Village Code grants authorization to the Mayor of the Village of Roselle to enter executive orders "upon the declaration of a local state of emergency"; and

WHEREAS, the authority to declare a state of emergency and to issue local executive orders under Chapter 2 Article XIX is exclusive to the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2020, I the Mayor of the Village of Roselle, Andrew Maglio, entered a declaration of local state of emergency based on the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, Governor Pritzker has issued a Gubernatorial Disaster Proclamation declaring that all counties in the State of Illinois, including DuPage and Cook Counties, are disaster areas due to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic is negatively affecting public transit including Metra resulting in a significant decrease in the number of commuters utilizing the commuter parking lots adjacent to the Roselle Metra Station; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article XIX, Section 10-19-113 and Article VI, Section 18-90 of the Roselle Municipal Code, municipal parking lots are under the supervision of the Police Chief; and

WHEREAS, the pandemic continues to exist and recent information indicates that the incidents of COVID 19 positivity and infections are once again on the rise; and

WHEREAS, I have concluded that under these unusual and extraordinary circumstances an Executive Order authorizing the Police Chief and Village Administrator to have the discretion necessary to temporarily modify the operations, manner, and use of the parking lots and train station including the closure of lots, use of parking spaces, availability of parking cards/permits, parking enforcement and fees, coffee vendor space, maintenance of the parking lots such as snow and ice control, and promote the public health, safety, and welfare and the efficient operations of the parking lots.

NOW, THEREFORE, BASED ON THE FOREGOING RECITALS, I, Andrew Maglio, as Mayor of the Village of Roselle hereby order instanter pursuant to my executive powers granted by law and the declaration of emergency as follows:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as if fully set forth as substantive provisions.

SECTION 2. I hereby authorize and direct the Police Chief, or his designee, with the authority to impose any conditions , management and controls upon the parking lots which, based on the current circumstances, that he deems necessary and appropriate for the public health, safety, and welfare.

SECTION 3. I further authorize and direct the Village Administrator, or his designee, to undertake any and all administrative acts necessary to effectuate the purpose of this order.

SECTION 4. The Roselle Police Department shall continue to enforce improper parking, overtime parking, and other parking offenses, including unauthorized use of parking places reserved for persons with disabilities, fire lane violations, and any other violations that may pose a danger to the public or restrict the ease of traffic movement within the parking lots.


SECTION 5. Unless the corporate authorities adopt an ordinance repealing this Executive Order, the modifications imposed to effectuate the purpose of this order shall remain in effect through March 31, 2021 and/or until the return of commuter demand allows for a reevaluation and possible reinstatement of operations in effect prior to this Executive Order being issued.

SECTION 6. Any modifications to the parking lots operations imposed pursuant to this order shall be timely communicated to the Village Board and in accordance with the Village Board Procedural Policy may be placed on a future agenda for discussion and reconsideration by the Village Board.

SECTION 7. Should any provision of this order be declared invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, said declaration shall not affect the validity of the remainder of the order.

SECTION 8. This order shall become effective immediately, upon its signing by me and attestation by the Village Clerk.
