

2021 STREET CONSTRUCTION

Bulletin No. 1

April 19, 2021



On March 22, 2021, the Village Board awarded the contract for the 2021 Street Improvements & Pavement Patching Programs to Schroeder Asphalt Services, Inc. This year's program includes the resurfacing of various streets throughout the Village. See attached Location Map and the list of streets included in this year's program.

This project consists of the grinding and resurfacing of the deteriorated roadway segments. Specifically, the construction sequence will be as follows:

1. Intermittent Sidewalk and Curb & Gutter removal and replacement.
2. Underground utilities work. (Utility Frame Adjustment, Structure Reconstruction)
3. Asphalt surface removal. (Grinding)
4. Asphalt patching of failed base course.
5. First layer paving with Hot-Mix Asphalt Leveling Binder.
6. Final layer paving with Hot-Mix Asphalt Surface Course.
7. Pavement marking/stripping

During construction, roads will remain open and driveway access will be maintained. The Village will work closely with the contractor to minimize the inconvenience to you during the project. Phase-1 construction is scheduled to begin the week of April 26 and anticipated completion date is May 28. Resident can expect varying level of activity during that timeframe.

Weather permitting; our street contractor will begin the first sequence of the 2021 Street Program, intermittent curb and sidewalk removal and replacement work the week of April 26, 2021. Prior to curb removal, our contractor will be notifying the affected residents to remove all vehicles from their garage and park them on the street. To some residents there will be a period of a few days after concrete curb is removed and replaced that access to their driveways will be restricted. Parking on the street or a nearby side street will be allowed in those cases. The newly poured concrete curb will take 4 to 7 days to cure, after which access to driveways will be restored.

Keeping residents informed about the progress of the Village's Street Improvement program is very important to us. In addition to this bulletin, we are posting regular construction updates on the Village's website at www.roselle.il.us/construction.
