



# OFFICIAL RULES



## REGISTRATION

- \* Participants/groups may sign up using the link found at [roselle.il.us/winterfest](https://roselle.il.us/winterfest)
- \* Registration form must be submitted by **Friday, November 17, 2023 @ 11:59pm CST**

## REQUIREMENTS

- \* One house per participant or group
- \* All houses must be placed on a 1/2" to 3/4" thick base no larger than 18"x18" with no legs
- \* All houses must be less than 18" tall (including base)
- \* Base should be completely covered
- \* All decorations must be 100% edible
- \* Non-edible decorations CAN be used to decorate the base only
- \* Design must include a snowman

## PRESENTATION

- \* Houses should be brought to Roselle Public Library for display on **Friday, December 1, from 2-5pm** and **Saturday, December 2, from 10am-Noon, 2023**
- \* Only minor assembly/repairs will be allowed at drop off; all homes should be as complete and ready as possible for transport
- \* Houses need to be picked up at the library on **Sunday December 3rd, from 1-5pm**, or they will be disposed

## VOTING

- \* Public votes (1 vote per person) will be cast by paper ticket during the Winterfest celebrations on **Saturday, December 2, 2023 from 2-4:30pm**

## RECOGNITION

- \* The 1st and 2nd place winners will be announced at the **Winterfest Tree Lighting Ceremony at 5pm**
- \* Winning houses will be exhibited in Village Hall during the week of December 4th
- \* Houses can be picked up at any time during the week of December 11; any house not picked up by the time Village Hall closes on Friday, December 15 will be disposed of.
